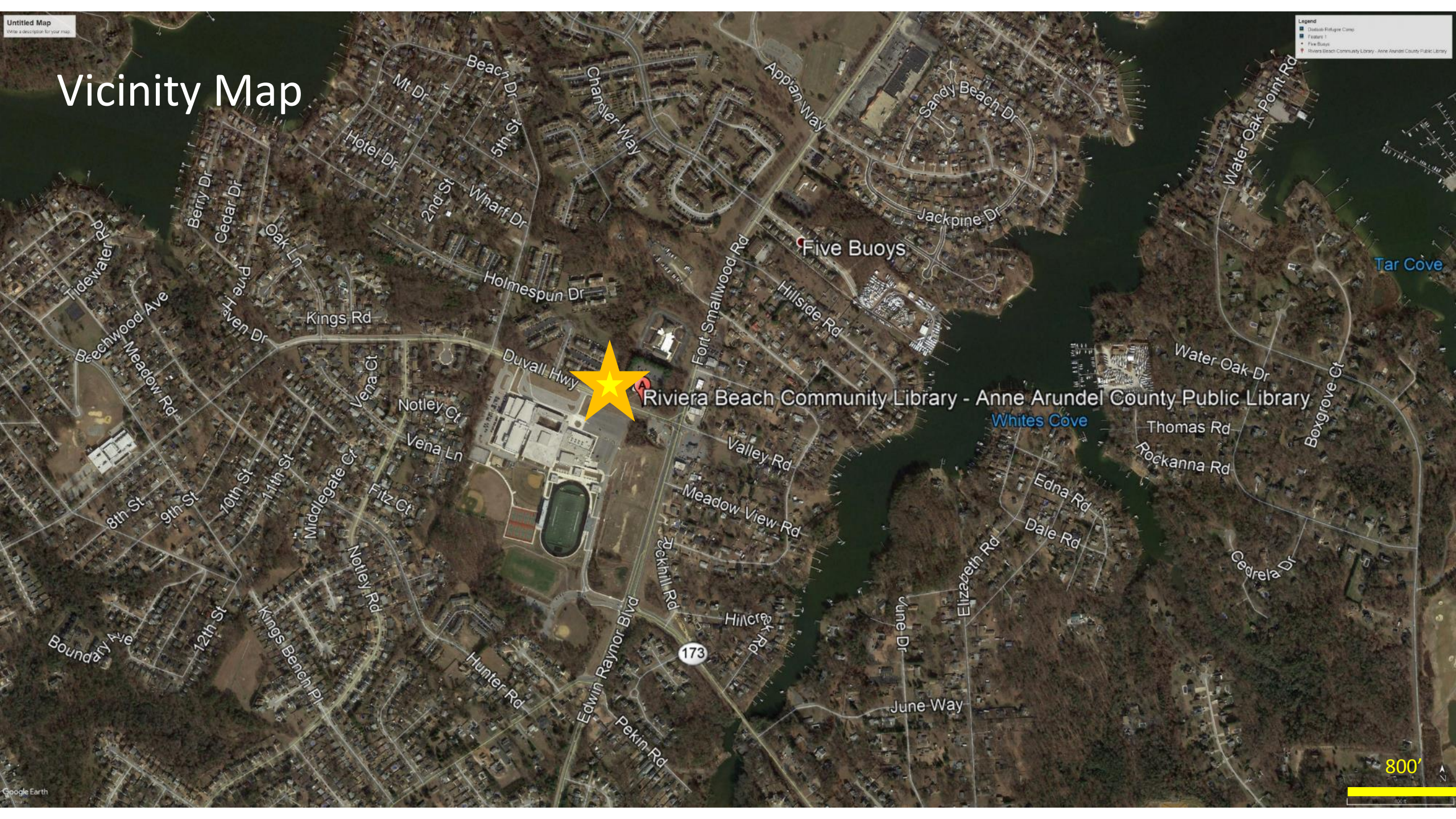
1. Programming – In progress

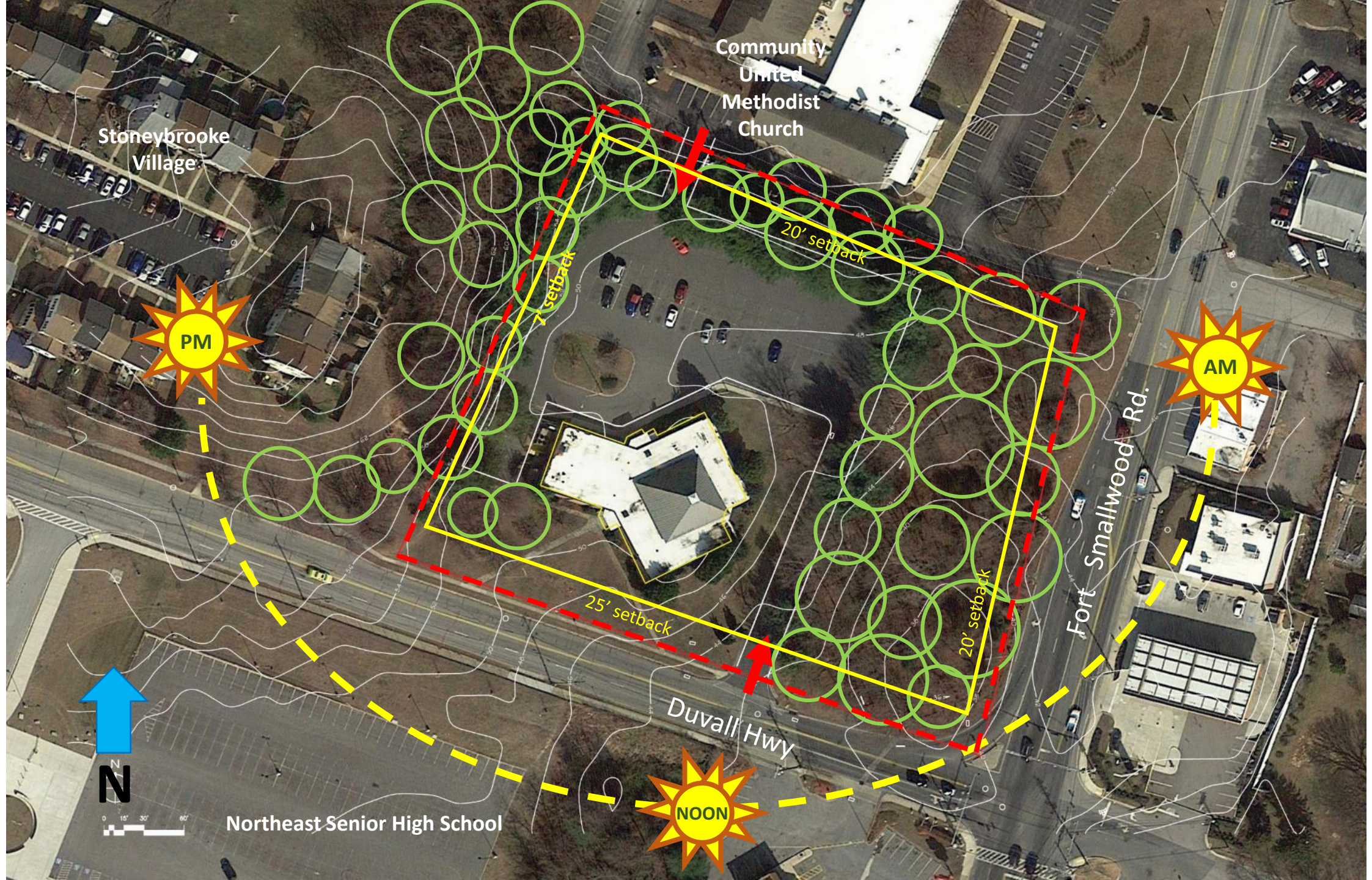

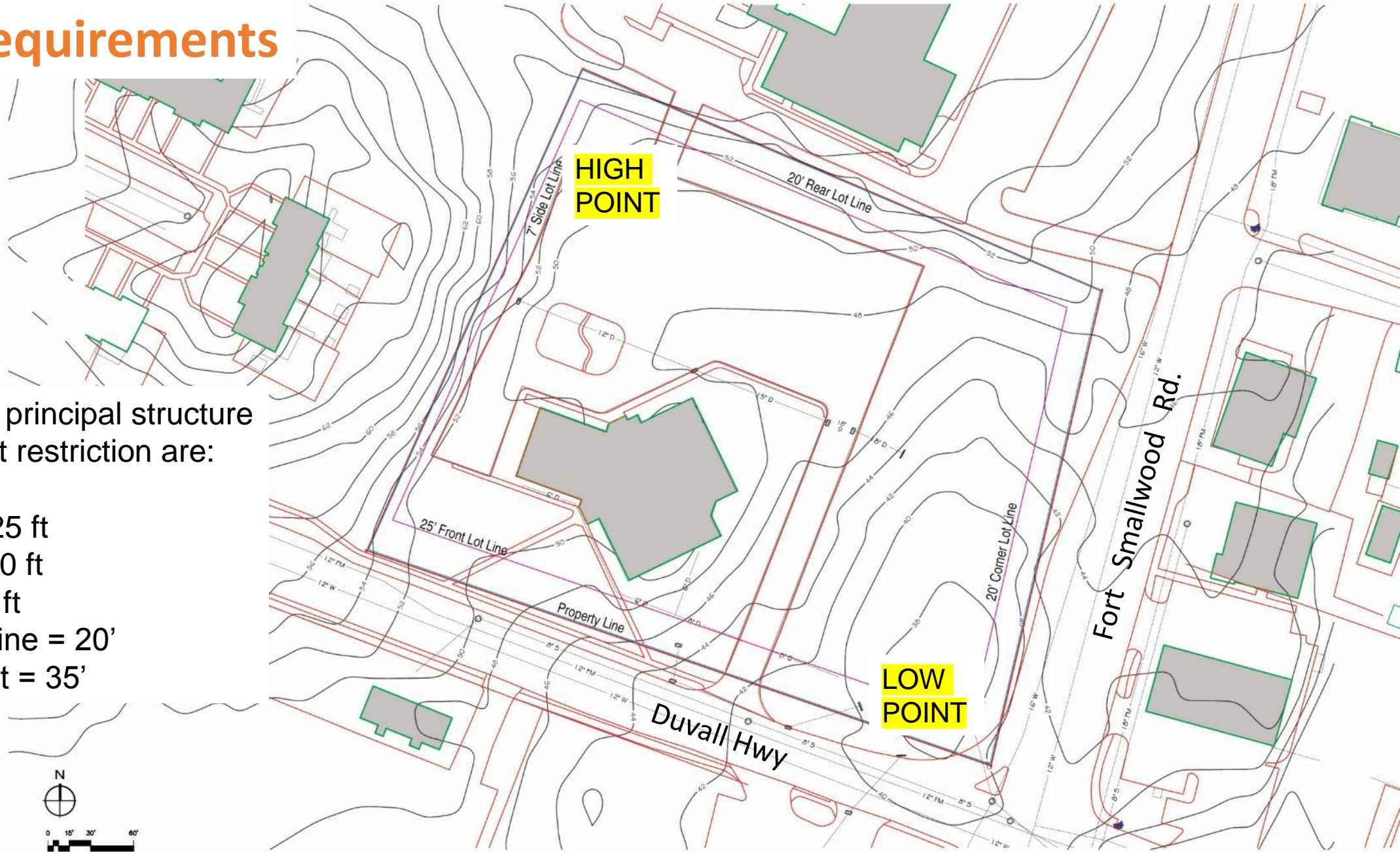

Zoning Requirements

Zoning is R5 so principal structure set-backs/height restriction are:

- Front lot line = 25 ft
- Rear lot line = 20 ft
- Side lot line = 7 ft
- Side corner lot line = 20'
- Maximum height = 35'
